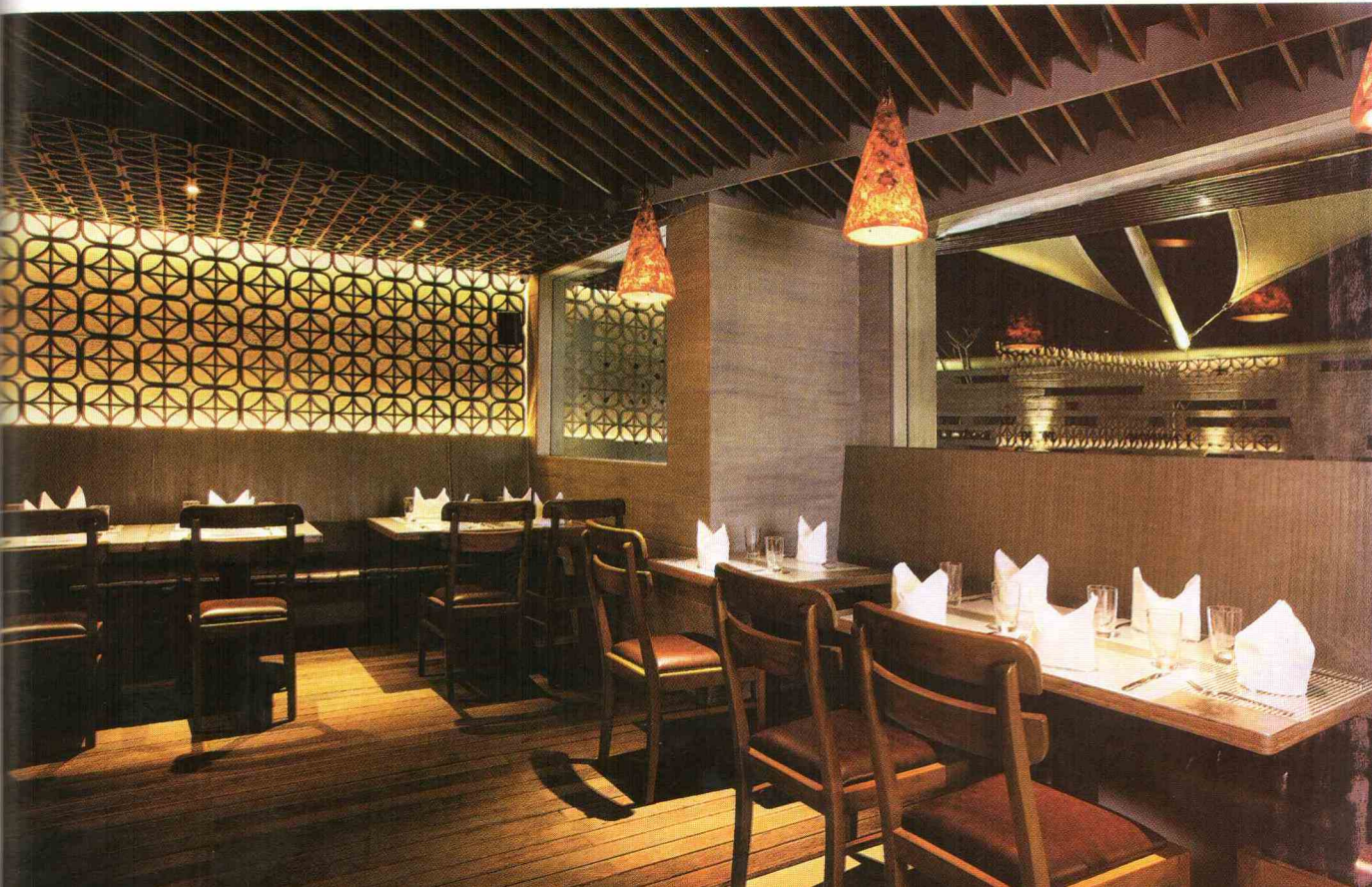

International exposure has opened up newer vistas in such space conceptualizing, positioning and planning, according to Sumesh and Vivek. Therefore they capitalized on Indian techniques and craftsmanship along with their international design experience to give this space a fusion look. Their unconventional use of lattices, local woods and inlays, lends the decor its mysticism.

Trikaya has neat segregation of spaces, where each section has its own ambiance. The 24-seater outdoor section is a splendid place to enjoy a drink. The indoor section has a seating arrangement for 45. It also has a dedicated floor space for those who like to hang out at the bar or even dance.

Each section has an innovative design story with handcrafted wood works adorning the ceiling. The customized material palette seems like it has been continuously researched, prototyped, and applied in this space. From concrete cast flooring, to resin-bonded stone counters, to machine printed table tops, all materials are innovatively used.
